

When will we know what teams are playing in Vancouver?

We'll find out in late 2025, during FIFA's Final Draw, a major event where all the teams that have qualified for the tournament are randomly placed into groups. This draw determines who plays where in the early stages of the World Cup. That's when we'll learn which teams—besides the Canadian Men's National Team—will be playing their matches in Vancouver.

Where can I get tickets for FIFA World Cup 26™?

The first ticket application period opens on Wednesday, September 10, 2025. To get started, visit FIFA.com/tickets, register your interest, and create a FIFA ID. This will ensure you're ready to enter the ticket draw and receive updates directly from FIFA.
